
Programs for Parents:

The ASCA National Model brings school counselors together with one vision and one voice, which creates unity and focus toward improving student achievement.

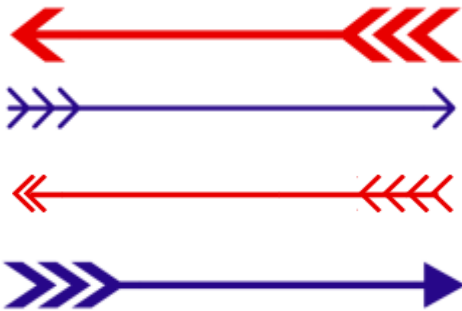
